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| 27. Semillon Sauvignon Blanc Groot Constantia – Western Cape
Groot Constantia is South Africa's oldest estate and one of South Africa's most visited tourist attractions. Ripe summer fruit flavours such as pineapple, sweet melon and ripe peach are in abundance on the nose. | 29. Ciclos Fume Blanc Bodegas El Esteco
Fume Blanc is oak aged Sauvignon! Coming from one of the oldest family estates and highest vineyard (1700m above sea level). This is truly a remarkable and delicious wine. | 30. Larry Cherubino Hen & Chicken Chardonnay
Named 'Winery of the Year' in James Halliday's 2011 Wine Companion. Aromas of melon, citrus and minerals, follow through on the palate. Fruit wash and-picked, whole bunch pressed, fermented with natural yeasts and aged in new and 2 year old French oak for 8 months with 80% undergoing malolactic fermentation. | Australia | 35.00 |
| 31. Chablis Jean Marc Brocard
The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose. | France | 35.00 |

The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine in its own right with a richly structured palate and aromas of apples, vanilla and toast. | Italy | 35.00 |
| 33. St Aubin 1er Cru 'Les Charmois' Domaine Marc Morey – Burgundy
Morey have been producing wines since 1919. Lemon peel combines with orange, vanilla and hints of smokeiness. Medium to full bodied with more citrus on the palate. It has heaps of minerality and good acidity keeping the mouth lively. The finish is clean with buttery elements. | France | 60.00 |

36. Naturalys Pinot Noir Gerard Bertrand 100% Organic Pinot Noir. from the 'King of the Languedoc'. The grape of Burgundy, elegant, velvety and well balanced with inviting wild raspberry and ripe cherry aromas.	France	28.00

Doña Paula is a leading, modern winery at the forefront of exploring and investing in new, high quality wine regions in Argentina.	Argentina	27.00

Carmenère Gran Reserva Carmen The Gran Reserva Carmenere is a dense and concentrated wine with intense red fruit character on the nose with hints of sweet spices and tobacco, cedar and oak and earthy aromas. Full bodied with lovely balance and a deep, velvety texture with beautiful length. Viña Carmen were responsible for identifying Carmenere, which had previously been thought of as Merlot.	Chile	28.00
49. Barossa Reserve Shiraz Berton Vineyard An espresso of a wine! This wine is bursting with blackberry and plum aromas enhanced by toasty, oaky, vanilla notes. The palate is full flavoured and intense with blackberry, blueberry fruit and sweet spicy notes supported by ripe, dense tannins, giving the palate great structure and length.	Australia	30.00
50. ‘Talo’ Malvasia Nera, Salento San Marzano – Puglia Deep ruby red with an intense and complex bouquet with notes of red fruits and spices. A full bodied wine with delicious flavours of blackberry jam and vanilla notes through to a smooth finish. Great with roasted meats, rich sauces and mature cheeses.	Italy	31.00
51. Nipozzano Chianti Rufina Reserva DOCCG The benchmark of Chianti Riserva, Nipozzano has a vibrant personality full of wild berry, cherry and violet notes underpinned with spicy aromas.	Italy	34.00

53. Gran Reserva Quasar – Rioja Deep ruby red with brick hues, this mature wine shows aromatic complexity of red berries, liquorice and hints of smokiness with earthy and savoury notes. The flavour is smooth, long and with good backbone. Bodegas Ondarre, is based in Viana, a historic town 6 kilometres from Logroño, Rioja capital.	Spain	35.00
54. Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon & Melot Trinita, Piattelli Vineyards – Mendoza A complex elegant wine with an aromatic bouquet of coffee and spice. This unfolds across the palette with sweetness and a hint of chocolate. Excellent with slow cooked meat and rich sauces.	Argentina	36.00
55. Collezione 50 Vino Rosso Cantina San Marzano NV – Puglia Ruby red colour with purple reflections, intense and complex bouquet with fruity notes of prune, red jam, the spicy scent of vanilla and liquorice. Intense on the palate, full bodied and soft with a long finish. In 1962, 19 vine growers from San Marzano, whose families had farmed the land for generations, combined their efforts to establish ‘Cantine San Marzano’. Through the decades this co-operative has grown significantly, attracting over 1200 vine growers, using modern and technologically advanced plants and producing elegant wines without forgetting the obligation to the ancient Apulian wine traditions. 56. Cigalus Rouge Gerard Bertrand Intense ruby colour with a mahogany hue. First the bouquet shouts concentrated, very ripe black fruit. After a little time in the glass, more complexity with grilled spice and toasted oak unfolds. The palate is lush and opulent with velvety tannins and aromas of black fruit – blackberries, black cherries and plums.	France	49.00

57. Sancerre Rouge la Croix du Roy Aromas of cherry, strawberry, blackberry and some vanilla on the nose. Medium-bodied and silky on the plate, displaying red berry fruit mixed with savoury notes.	France	55.00
58. Château De Valois Pomerol 2010 Intense cassis aromas followed by hints of toast on the nose. On the palate it has notes of fruit, morello cherries and dark chocolate and big but ripe tannins, finishing with a hint of cedar and vanilla. Château de Valois was built in 1862 from the restructuring of the original vineyards of Château Figeac. Today the same family owns it and constantly improves the quality and produces great Pomerol wines. The vineyard was totally replanted in 1956.	France	65.00
59. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Domaine De La Solitude, Cuvée Barberini 2010 The property has a glorious past. Wines have been made at this place for several hundred years. Often the owners have had connection to the church. The three hats on the label refer to two bishops and a pope among the forefathers of the Lancon family. The first member of the family in France came from Italy in 1264 to serve the pope in Avignon. His name was Barberini - the name today of the special cuvées from the domain.	France	69.00
60. Frankland Shiraz Larry Cherubino 2009 This is massive, you need to be sitting down and drinking this with a knife and fork! On the nose, intense blueberry, white pepper and spice. The palate sits well and truly in the savoury spectrum with smoky spice, tobacco and earthiness complementing the deep dark fruit profile. Extremely complex with cinnamon, star anise and white pepper notes. The wine is dense, intense and powerful, yet the palate retains a silky elegance. The tannins are fine and the wine can be cellared with confidence.	Australia	65.00
61. Château du Domine de L'Eglise Pomerol - Bordeaux, 2010 Enticing aromas of sweet cherry, subtle spice and red fruit. Touch of oak on the finish. Layered flavour and complexity that develops well in the glass.	France	75.00
62. Amarone Rocolo Grassi DOCG Hand crafted wine from Veneto. Astonishingly rich and multilayered with lots of ripe dark berry fruits and concentration. Dark chocolate and cigar box aromas. A very small harvest of only the very best grapes from the single vineyard. The grapes are then dried in an open cellar and then only the richest free run juice is allowed for collection and fermentation. This can take up to 4 years.	Italy	80.00
62a. Lamaione Toscana IGT 100% Merlot. Outstanding, Robust and fully developed structure. Leather and tobacco aromas leading to rich opulent and inviting flavours of blackfruit and spice. Opening up into an amazing concentration of layered unctuous bliss.	Italy	85.00
63. Nuits St Georges 1^{er} Cru Clos Des Perrieres, 2009 Sweet cherry fruit with hints of violets. This wine displays an attractive purity of complex fruit flavours combined with elegance and finely grained tannins.	France	95.00
64. Château Cantenac Brown 3^{eme} Cru Classé, Margaux - Bordeaux, 200 Iconic wine from the heart of Margaux. A wealth of history dating back to 1769. Generations of heritage and hand crafted wines, showing great structure and body. Leather cedar wood and darkfruit with a hint of rich vibrant fruit.	France	125.00
65. Marchesi De' Frescolbaldi Giramonte, Tenuta Di Castiglione, 2009 A complex aromatic medley ranging from wild red berry fruits to hints of pungent clove, and nuances of lively menthol. The palate impresses with its velvety smoothness, appealing mouthfeel and concentration with a long-lingering, silky finish.	Italy	125.00
