<b>55. Collezione 50 Vino Rosso</b>	Cantina San Marzano NV – Puglia	<b>Italy</b>	47.00
Ruby red colour with purple reflections, intense and complex bouquet with fruity notes of prune, red jam, the spicy scent of vanilla and liquorice. Intense on the palate, full bodied and soft with a long finish.			
In 1962, 19 vine growers from San Marzano, whose families had farmed the land for generations, combined their efforts to establish ‘Cantine San Marzano’. Through the decades this co-operative has grown significantly, attracting over 1200 vine growers, using modern and technologically advanced plants and producing elegant wines without forgetting the obligation to the ancient Apulian wine traditions.			
<b>56. Cigalus Rouge</b>	Gérard Bertrand	<b>France</b>	51.00
Intense ruby colour with a mahogany hue. First the bouquet shouts concentrated, very ripe black fruit. After a little time in the glass, more complexity with grilled spice and toasted oak unfolds. The palate is lush and opulent with velvety tannins and aromas of black fruit – blackberries, black cherries and plums.

- 100. Bordeaux Supérieur Château Lestrille Capmartin 2014 – Bordeaux** **France** 36.00  
A medium-bodied Bordeaux showing concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. In the mouth it has good freshness, while the structure shows high quality tannins.
- 101. Lussac Saint-Émilion Château Mayne Blanc 2015 – Bordeaux** **France** 51.00  
Deep berryed fruits are accompanied by a blueberry character and rich, dark chocolate notes. Stylish and deliciously approachable.
- 103. Sangiovese Rubicone 'Tauleto' Umberto Cesari 2012 – Emilia Romagna** **Italy** 62.00  
An opulent and full-bodied wine with flavours of ripe cherries and coconut. Smooth, concentrated and intense.
- 104. Fronsac Bordeaux Château Puy Guilhem 2009** **France** 66.00  
A powerful yet elegant red with ripe berryed fruits enhanced by a subtle note of oak spice. Full bodied, with juicy fruit and an attractive savoury note on the finish.
- 105. Shiraz 'Single Vineyard' Jim Barry Wines 2015** **Australia** 67.00  
Opulent aromas of rich, bright red fruits are supported by a core of classic Clare Valley spice. Beautifully structured with fine savoury tannins and terrific length of vibrant fruit on the palate. Not your typical Clare Valley Shiraz!
- 106. Pomerol Château de Valois 2014** **France** 68.00  
Intense cassis aromas followed by hints of toast on the nose. On the palate it has notes of fruit, morello cherries and dark chocolate and big but ripe tannins, finishing with a hint of cedar and vanilla. Château de Valois was built in 1862 from the restructuring of the original vineyards of Château Figeac. Today the same family owns it and constantly improves the quality and produces great Pomerol wines. The vineyard was totally replanted in 1956.
- 107. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Domaine de la Solitude, Cuvée Barberini 2015** **France** 71.00  
The property has a glorious past. Wines have been made at this place for several hundred years. Often the owners have had connection to the church. The three hats on the label refer to two bishops and a pope among the forefathers of the Lancon family. The first member of the family in France came from Italy in 1264 to serve the pope in Avignon. His name was Barberini – the name today of the special cuvées from the domain.
