A spicy, punchy and moreish red with attractive floral aromas, vibrant fruit compote and vanilla notes in the background. Full and opulent.
35. **Primitivo 'Il Pumo'** San Marzano  Italy 27.00
Incredible depth of colour, with perfumes of spicy, ripe, black cherries and a hint of liquorice on the nose. On the palate it is full-bodied yet well structured, with full flavours of ripe black fruit. Pair with grilled meats.
36. **Pinot Noir, 'Naturalys'** Gérard Bertrand  France 30.00
An easy drinking style of Pinot with enticing aromas of ripe caramelised summer fruits and a hint of caramel.
37. **Pinot Noir 'The Nest'** Lake Chalice New Zealand 31.00
A light bodied and juicy Pinot Noir with aromatic notes of sweet ripe strawberries, dried herbs and red cherry.
38. **Fleurie** Olivier Ravier  France 34.00
Full, enticing aromas of black cherry and floral notes lead on to a round and elegant palate packed with red fruits.

A fresh and juicy Shiraz with blackberry, black cherry and plum fruit flavours.
40. **Rioja Reserva** Bodegas Ondarre  Spain 31.00
Leather and spice of traditionally made Rioja on the nose. Smooth and subtle on the palate, with strawberries and vanilla ice cream sustained through to a long finish with well integrated tannins.
41. **Il Bruciato** Antinori 2020 Italy 50.00
Oak, vanilla and chocolate- delicious!
42. **Cruel Mistress Pinot Noir** Larry Cherubino Australia 37.00
A wine with a pale ruby/salmon hue and sweet clove and black cherry aromas. A lush Pinot with sweet spice, smoky, leather and black plum flavours on the palate, all beautifully balanced.
43. **Bourgogne Pinot Noir** Domaine René Monnier France 37.00
Lovely Pinot Noir typicity on the nose with wild raspberry, ripe cherry and savoury notes. It is followed with pure vibrant redberry fruit supported with firm tannins, matured in French oak barrels for 10 months.
44. **Constantia Pinotage** Groot Constantia  South Africa 37.00
Medium intense wine with dark berry fruit, well-structured, medium tannins and a beautiful balance. The wine is made in a classic, traditional style. Enjoy with a good steak.
45. **'Gouverneurs Reserve'** Groot Constantia  South Africa 54.00
Ripe rich flavours of blackcurrant with hints of cedar, chocolate and graphite enveloped in a restrained.
46. **Ribera del Duero, Peña Roble Reserva**, Bodegas Resalte de Peñafiel  Spain 49.95
Ripe, dark fruits, liquorice, mineral and spice with roasted notes from the oak ageing.

- 100. Bordeaux Supérieur Château Lestrille Capmartin 2015** France 66.00
A medium-bodied Bordeaux showing concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes.
- 101. St Julien Bordeaux Château Gloria 2012** France 75.00
Cassis fruit and tobacco under a blanket of soft ripe tannins. Blackberry & Plum.
- 102. Saint Estèphe Château Ormes de Pez 2014** France 85.00
Saint Estèphe wines are powerful, concentrated and rich. This is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, giving hallmark notes of Cassis, blackcurrant and cigar box. It has tasty herbaceous and red berry flavours with a medium finish on the palate. A great wine from an excellent vintage.
- 103. Fugue de Néin Pomerol Château Néin 2014** France 75.00
A delicious, mellow and complete wine, made from 100% Merlot. Brooding blackcurrant, vanilla and oak on the palate. Pomerol wines are generally rich and decadent wines with soft tannins and full flavours.
- 104. Margaux Château Deyrem Valentin 2015** France 90.00
This 2015 Margaux is a great vintage displaying notes of cassis, black cherries and plums. It has distinct caramel sweetness with a rich, dark colour bursting with dark forest fruit flavours. It is made from 100% Merlot.
- 105. Cigalus Rouge Gérard Bertrand 2019**  France 51.00
Intense ruby colour with a mahogany hue. First the bouquet shouts concentrated, very ripe black fruit. After a little time in the glass, more complexity with grilled spice and toasted oak unfolds. The palate is lush and opulent with velvety tannins and aromas of black fruit - blackberries, black cherries and plums.
- 106. Pomerol Château de Valois 2016**  France 68.00
Intense cassis aromas followed by hints of toast on the nose. On the palate it has notes of fruit, morello cherries and dark chocolate and big but ripe tannins, finishing with a hint of cedar and vanilla. Château de Valois was built in 1862 from the restructuring of the original vineyards of Château Figeac. Today the same family owns it and constantly improves the quality and produces great Pomerol wines. The vineyard was totally replanted in 1956.
- 107. Vinsobres Les Hauts de Julien Famille Perrin**  France 45.00
A Southern Rhône red produced from Syrah (Shiraz). A beautiful rich and intense wine produced from 90 year old vines. Blackcurrent, black cherry, leather and oak.

100% Merlot. Outstanding, Robust and fully developed structure. Leather and tobacco aromas leading to rich opulent and inviting flavours of blackfruit and spice. Opening up into an amazing concentration of layered unctuous bliss.		
111. La Forge, Corbières Boutenac Gérard Bertrand 2017	France	98.00
An intensely flavoured and concentrated wine packed with exotic plum fruit, dark chocolate and figs.		
112. Ridge Geyserville 2018	USA	65.00

115. Giramonte, Tenuta Di Castiglione Marchesi de Frescobaldi 2012 	Italy	131.00
A complex aromatic medley ranging from wild red berry fruits to hints of pungent clove, and nuances of lively menthol. The palate impresses with its velvety smoothness, appealing mouthfeel and concentration with a long-lingering, silky finish.		
116. Guado al Tasso Bolgheri 2017	Italy	125.00
Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot blend. Deep ruby colour with aromas of black cherry, blackberry and plum with vanilla, tobacco and oak spice. A smooth finish with long earthy tones - one for the decanter		
117. Sassicaia Tenuta San Guido 2017	Italy	400.00
A superb Tuscan from Bolgheri. Intensely concentrated with notes of blackcurrant and bramble fruits, finely structured and supported by ripe cedar tannins.		
118. Tiganello Marchesi Antinori 2016	Italy	125.00
Produced by the Antinori Family who have been producing wine since 1385. Blend of Sangevese, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc. This is not for the faint hearted, even this young vintage shows maturity and character. Dense black fruit and tobacco.		
119. Sarget de Gruaud Larose St.Julien Château Gruaud Larose 1997	France	150.00
Produced from Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot. This wine albeit 24 years old is still hugely elegant and delicate. It displays crushed violets and morello cherries. A complex finish with very soft tannins.
